ESSENTIAL INFO

What to bring:

- CGI will provide sunscreen, if you would like a specific brand please send it to camp. (children should arrive at camp wearing sunscreen and we will reapply during the day)
- Sunhat or baseball cap
- Encouraged to wear closed-toe shoes
- Swimsuit, water shoes and towel (Mondays & Thursdays)
- Rashguards are encouraged on swimming days for added swim protection
- Camp T-Shirt on Trip Days (Monday, Wednesday & Friday)
- Water Bottles are optional as we provide water throughout the day

POLICIES AND INFORMATION SHEET

1. COVID-19 POLICIES

Please Note: CDC and County requirements for camp are ever-changing. We are working closely with our medical advisors and will send out a full covid policy the week before camp.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY.

We are unable to offer any refunds for the illness of a camper that prevents him/her from attending our program. If Camp Gan Izzy is forced to cancel or temporarily close a program due to a Covid infection, Camp Gan Izzy will offer a full refund for unused days (prorated) to all campers affected. Only those campers (and siblings) who are directly affected by the closure will be offered a refund..

2. CAMPER BEHAVIOR.

Camp Gan Israel fosters an inclusive atmosphere of mutual respect, cooperation, and courtesy between and among all campers and camp personnel. Disruptive, disrespectful, and discourteous behavior will not be allowed. If circumstances warrant, campers may be removed from camp activities, or parents may be required to take their campers home.

3. CELL PHONES, IPAD'S, TOYS AT CAMP

Cell phones, hand-held games, and other electronic devices are not permitted at camp. If they are brought to camp, they will need to be deposited in the camp office during camp hours. We cannot be responsible for any lost or stolen items. Please make certain that you have informed and instructed your camper on these policies.

4. EMERGENCIES

Each camper's registration form provided Camp Gan Israel with parent contact information and supplemental contact information was requested in the event of an emergency.

5. SUN PROTECTION:

We will be spending time outdoors each day. Please apply sunscreen on your child before they come to camp. We will have sunscreen for our campers, if you would like an alternative sunscreen please send it to camp.

Please send a cap or hat with your child for additional sun protection.

6. WATER DAYS

Mondays & Thursdays are Water Days! Please send a towel and a bathing suit or change of clothes for your child.

7. CAMP T-SHIRT

Every camper and staff member is required to wear their Camp Gan Israel tshirt on Mondays, Wednesdays, and on Fridays. Campers will receive one t-shirt on their first day at camp, additional t-shirts can be purchased for \$10.

9. ART & MESSY ACTIVITIES

Here at Gan Izzy, we believe that childhood is supposed to be messy and handson. We also love art and use an assortment of materials including acrylic paint, clay, and mod-podge. We will provide smocks for all art activities but please keep this in mind when dressing your children for camp.

10. TRANSPORTATION

Children will travel to field trip destinations on air-conditioned busses. We will go to Aqua Adventure via private vehicles. Please send a labelled booster on Mondays if your child needs one.

LUNCHES AT CAMP GAN ISRAEL

Gan Izzy serves a nutritious and delicious lunch each day for a cost of \$35 per week. If you choose to send your own lunch please send dairy or pareve (vegetarian) food. We will not be able to warm food.
